HELP KEEP US HEALTHY AND ON CAMPUS!

The updated COVID-19 Addendum 2021-2022 is posted on our website.

All students are required to wear a face covering.

Please monitor your child's symptoms before coming to school each morning.

Do not send your child to school if:

- they test positive for COVID
- have been in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID
- they are waiting for COVID test results
- someone in the household is waiting on COVID test results
- they show symptoms associated with COVID

Students who get sick at school, regardless of the cause, **MUST** be picked up and taken off campus immediately. They will be sent to the isolation room to wait.

We recognize that other conditions may present the same symptoms as COVID, and that many children may be asymptomatic carriers or show mild symptoms of COVID, so it may seem like they are okay to come to school. **HOWEVER**, we must be more cautious than ever if we want to keep all our Eagles on campus and healthy!

- Students in PreK-3 who do not have older siblings at school will be dismissed from 2:30-2:40 at the circle driveway facing St. Clement Avenue
• Circle driveway facing St. Clement Ave.- bus riders
• Carpool area by St. Clement Chapel- students in grades PreK-4 - 4th
• Cafeteria drive facing Price Street- students in grades 5-12
